

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
COASTSIDE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
FORMATION OF COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 35**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of a Public Hearing to be held on Wednesday, December 11, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at the Coastside Fire Protection District's Administrative Offices, 1191 Main Street, Half Moon Bay, CA to receive public comment on the adoption of a Resolution of Formation of Community Facilities District No. 35 ("CFD No. 35") to establish the boundaries of CFD No. 35, impose a special tax and fund fire protection and suppression services for CFD No. 35.

On October 23, 2019, the Board of Directors of the Coastside Fire Protection District adopted a "Resolution of Intention to Form Community Facilities District" to fund fire protection and suppression services for proposed CFD No. 35. The Resolution of Intention proposes the levy of a special tax upon parcels within the boundaries of CFD No. 35, and describes the rate, method of apportionment and manner of collection of the tax. A copy of the full text of the Resolution of Intention is available from the District's Administrative Secretary at the District's Administrative Offices.

At the Public Hearing, the Board of Directors will take testimony from interested persons or taxpayers for or against the establishment of CFD No. 35, the extent of CFD No. 35, the furnishing of the proposed services, and the levy of the special tax. Written comments may also be submitted prior to or at the Public Hearing.

If written protests against the establishment of CFD No. 35 are filed by either (1) 50 percent or more of the registered voters in CFD No. 35; or (2) the owner(s) of one-half or more of the land in the proposed CFD No. 35 and not exempt from the proposed tax, the Board of Directors shall undertake no further proceedings to form CFD No. 35 or to levy the proposed special tax for a period of one year. Alternatively, if the required majority of registered voters or property owners protest only the proposed special tax or those specified services, the Resolution of Formation will be revised to eliminate that specified special tax or those specified services, so that the proceedings to form CFD No. 35 may thereafter continue.

A mailed ballot election will be held following the adoption of the Resolution of Formation. The election will be held pursuant to the procedures outlined in Government Code Section 53326 et seq.
