Required Contractor Registration: Owner shall accept bids only from bidders that are currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5.

Prevailing Wage Laws: The successful bidder must comply with all prevailing wage laws applicable to the Project, and related requirements contained in the Contract Documents. This Project is subject to prevailing wage compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

Reservation of Rights: Owner specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all bids, to re-bid, or to waive inconsequential defects in bidding not involving time, price or quality of the work. Owner may reject any and all Bids and waive any minor irregularities in the bids.

Bid Preparation Cost: Bidders are solely responsible for the cost of preparing their bids.

Instructions to Bidders: Bids must include: 1) a total, lump-sum bid price for all work required to complete the Project; 2) proof of the bidder's registration with the Department of Industrial Relations; 3) contractor's license number(s); 4) a description of work experience; 5) a proposed Project schedule; and 6) proof of insurance required by the Contract Documents.
